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ABSTRACT

This research was conducted to investigate the ability of the students of SMP Negeri 1 Seruway Aceh Tamiang in writing task based on gender. The writer used a qualitative approach. It tried to describe the phenomenon about students' ability and their real ability through test result. Therefore, she used questioner and test for her instruments. The questioner employed some questions about asking their opinion for their ability in doing writing task. Meanwhile, test was used to find out their real ability in doing writing task. The writer used Likert scale to find out the opinion of students based on gender.

As a result, the finding of this research supported the theory about gender characteristic which is male prefer to talk openly about their ability while and the female felt reluctant to express openly their ability, although the fact show different result. The test result showed that female student scored higher than male student. Where by 25% of female perform and on 15% mal student scored average which is still below the standard. It is recommendation to English teacher of SMP Negeri 1 Seruway to do more communication approach to the student about their learning performance. It can be started by asking their preference in learning and method in order, the English teacher could choose the right technique or method to improve their ability in writing.

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Research

English as an international language has four integrated skills. There are many kinds of subjects in teaching learning process, one of the basic language skills is writing. Writing English becomes very important in using English for communication in written mode. Someone is considered to be competent in language if he or she is clever to scrutinize, read and write in and by using the language. Writing is one of the important skills that people need to master.
