By incorporating or acknowledging tiktok literacy practices, teachers can potentially rely on digital literacy that ultimately shapes students and their understanding of culture.<sup>33</sup>

The second research entitled "The Use of Tiktok Application: The Impact on Students' Vocabulary and Attitude" which was conducted by Yossi Rahmawati dan Anwar 2022. Researchers show that students are positive about using TikTok to learn English. Emotional, behavioral, and cognitive aspects of attitudes are used to classify the data. The majority of students have a good attitude towards her three elements. According to the interview results, most students agreed that the TikTok application could make learning English more fun. They also agreed that the TikTok application helps improve their English skills. They also agreed that learning English through TikTok could have many benefits, such as TikTok

#### **CHAPTER III**

#### **RESEARCH METHOD**

#### A. Research Design

This study relates to students' interest in reading through Tiktok applications in English classes. Therefore, researchers need to conduct descriptive studies, especially studies that provide descriptive data such as students' written and spoken utterances and observed behaviors. The authors use qualitative research that intensively carries out a detailed and convergent view of the research subject to answer the questions considered. The data that appears in qualitative is formed by words, not numbers where data is obtained by observation. According to A. Muri Yusuf, qualitative research prioritizes the search for meanings, understandings, concepts, properties, symptoms, symbols, explanations of phenomena, focuses on multiple ways, is natural and holistic, Strategic research that prioritizes quality and multiple uses. It has methods and is narratively expressed. Simply put, the purpose of qualitative research is to find answers to phenomena or questions through the systematic application of scientific procedures using a qualitative approach.<sup>37</sup> The description technique is an analysis that aims to describe and analyze students' reading interest in social media, namely the tiktok application.

#### **B.** Place and Time of Research

Then during the process of carrying out teaching practices, the researcher found problems related to the title which would be studied in more depth and to get clearer information, the researcher decided to conduct research on students from that school.

#### C. Data and Data Source

Researchers used samples from primary and secondary data sources. Data sources can be divided into her two categories: primary data and secondary data.

1. Primary data

Primary data relating to the subject of this study were selected directly by the researcher. In this type of research, the primary data sources are observations and interviews with research subjects.

2. Secondary data

Secondary data is a source of data taken by researchers indirectly from the subject. It can be from books, journals, etc. that are relevant. The secondary data source of this research is accepted to complement the primary data.

Based on the theory above, the data source of the researcher uses primary data as a source for processing data. While secondary data is used as a theoretical reference such as journals.

#### **D.** Procedure of Data Collection

Data collection techniques are a way to collect data to answer the formulation of the in collecting data, the researcher used observation and interview. They are :

#### 1. Observation

Observation is the activity of seeing and observing the object of research to determine the influence, development, impact, and so on. In this case, observations can be made in various ways.<sup>38</sup> Starting from observations on direct objects, observations by directly involving themselves in the field, to observations by reviewing references in the literature. Researchers observed student activities at each meeting so that researchers could measure student abilities, then the results of these observations were entered into the observation sheet. The researcher also wants to know whether the tiktok application can increase students' interest in reading. In addition to the general understanding, experts and experts have different views and opinions in defining what observation is.

The following is the meaning of observation according to experts, according to Heru observation is an observation showing a study or learning that is carried out

- Participatory observation, i.e. observation made by the researcher when he himself is directly involved in the activities of the subject being observed.
- Non-participatory observation is when the researcher makes observations, but he himself does not involve himself in the activities carried out by the research subject.
- Systematic observation is when the observer has prepared a framework or list of things to be observed (check list).
- Experimental observations are observations made on conditions that have been prepared in advance to find out the conditions being tested.

Based on the above statement, researchers discovered through systematic observation whether the Tiktok application can increase students' interest in reading. In addition, we need to examine how Tiktok applications influence students' interest in reading in multimodal literacy. In observation activities

#### 2. Interview

An interview is a conversation between two or more people between a source and an interviewer with the purpose of gathering data in the form of information. The following is the definition of an interview according to experts.<sup>41</sup> According to Lexy J. Moleong, the concept of an interview is a conversation with a specific purpose, in which a researcher and a respondent face-to-face (face-to-face) verbally collect information and explain research problems. The goal is to obtain data that can be.<sup>42</sup> According to Koentjaraningrat, interviews are a method used for certain tasks, trying to get information or verbally forming respondents, to communicate face to face.<sup>43</sup>

Here are some types of interviews that are often used complete with a brief explanation.

- Semi-structured interviews are interview processes that are conducted using interview instruments or guides but are more flexible than structured interviews. Researchers can develop research questions according to the desired information needs.<sup>44</sup>
- Unstructured interviews, namely interviews conducted where researchers are free to ask questions without using interview guidelines. Unstructured interviews can also be said to be informal interviews. Even though interview guidelines have been prepared, in practice the conversation is more friendly.

Based on the type of interview, the researcher used unstructured interviews to get more in-depth answers related to the use of the tiktok application for students of SMPN 8 Langsa for students' reading interest skills. Interviews were given to students each with 10 questions. Where to interview students, the questions that the researcher will ask are in the form of their experiences in using the tiktok application and also about how often they read the videos in the tiktok application. For student interviews, the researcher only selected five students to be interviewed. Then this interview will be divided into two days. With the time determined by each resource person for 20-20 minutes at each meeting.

#### 3. Documentation

Documents consist of personal notes, such as letters and official documentation and to obtain data from notes, transcripts, books, magazines, agendas and others.<sup>45</sup>

The following are some definitions of documentation according to experts. According to Paul Otlet Documentation is an activity in the form of collecting, processing, storing, retrieving, and disseminating a document.<sup>46</sup> According to Sugiyono, documentation is a record of past events. Documents may take the form of texts, photographs, and monumental works of people. Written documents (diaries, life stories, stories, biographies, regulations, policies, etc.). Documents in image format such as photographs, live videos, sketches, etc.<sup>47</sup>

Based on the statement above, it can be said that documentation is one of the techniques used to obtain data from documents and written materials. In this research, the documents used are supporting data in the form of pictures for observation. Research results from observations and interviews will be more accurate and reliable if they are supported by photographs. Then, the purpose of the document is to strengthen the data from observations.

#### E. Data Analysis

However, the two are distinguishable. A fundamental feature of both types of research is the use of naturalistic data. In other words, we seek to study language learning and teaching in a natural environment without interfering or manipulating variables. Nevertheless, these two types of research may differ in terms of their goals, level of management and data analysis methods. In this research, the researcher will conduct the data analysis are:

1. Data Collection

This step consists of translating the results of the voice interview into text (transcript), scanning the material, entering the field data, and categorizing and organizing the data into different types depending on the information source.<sup>48</sup> It helps researchers to encode important information from activities carried out during research. That research can actually start some data analysis in the field, while collecting data. Furthermore, the coding process is an ongoing process as categories can be changed, combined or deleted, new categories are generated and new relationships can be found.

2. Data Reduction

Data reduction is a form of analysis that refines, classifies, focuses, discards, and organizes data in ways that can be proven to draw final conclusions. Data reduction was applied based on research question. Data that does not match the research questions asked are discarded.<sup>49</sup> In this case, the researcher only

identified reading interest using the TikTok application. All data captured is transcribed and the selected data is organized for display. Therefore, data that is not important is reduced by researchers.

#### 3. Drawing Conclusion

Drawing Conclusions is the process of taking the essence of the data presentation that has been organized in the form of short and concise sentence statements and or formulas but containing broad meanings. At this conclusion drawing stage the activity carried out is to provide conclusions on the data resulting from the interpretation. If the results of this conclusion are not strong, then verification is needed. Verification is testing the truth, robustness, and matching the meanings that emerge from the data. Implementation of verification is a re-purpose of field recording or review.<sup>50</sup>

Presentation of data presents a simple process of presenting data in the form of tables and graphs so that the data collected is controlled by the researcher as the basis for making appropriate conclusions. In research, the data shown comes from observations and interviews. Then, the researcher explained about students' interest in reading in the tiktok application.

#### **CHAPTER IV**

#### FINDINGS AND DISCUSSION

#### A. Findings

The data in this study were collected from observations, interviews and documentation. The data focused on students' interest in reading in using the Tiktok application and students' opinions of the Tiktok application if it was used as a reading medium for students at SMPN 8 Langsa. This research was conducted from Wednesday, 11 January 2023 to Thursday, 12 January 2023.

Based on the results of data collection and analysis, researchers found that; 1) From reading interest in the Tiktok application, students are very interested in using Tiktok social media as a medium for their reading interest. Then, 2) Students spend a lot of time everyday on the Tiktok application to read. Furthermore, 3) Students consider the Tiktok application as a positive application if it is used properly, and students agree that the Tiktok application is used as a medium for students' reading interest.

#### 1. Students use the Tiktok application as a reading medium

The Tik Tok application fulfills the criteria of a good learning media, which is attractive and close to students, especially in the field of reading. Students use the Tiktok application as a reading medium by looking at writings from FYP Tiktok. An example of students using Tiktok as a medium for reading is filtering the basic competencies of reading news texts. Students consider Tiktok to provide a lot of positive writings and learning for students. When students want to find knowledge, students like to search on tiktok. Through the Tik Tok application, students can easily read interactively, so that it can be adapted to the environment, situation and conditions of the students.

# 2. Students are very interested in using Tiktok social media as a medium for their reading interest.

As a first step in collecting data to determine students' reading interest in using the Tiktok application, the researcher conducted class observations which were carried out on Tuesday, January 10 2023. Regarding students' reading interest in using the Tiktok application, the researcher conducted observation activities consisting of students using the Tiktok application. the Tik Tok application. From the results of observations, the average student has a tiktok account, and students like to read on the tiktok application, but the use of reading in learning English does not all students like to watch, some like to read hadith and read quotes from tiktok.

To find out students' understanding, the results of interviews were conducted with six students. Researchers classify in terms of student interest in reading and students' opinions if the Tiktok application is used as a reading medium. Based on the results of interviews that have been collected by researchers in the reading interest section, there are four students who really like reading from the Tiktok application, namely FB, MS, WMA, DEZ and two students only read through their FYP. According to FB, MS, WMA, DEZ there is a connection between students' interest in reading by using the Tiktok application, because according to them, tiktok is an application that can support students' interest in reading. In their opinion, Tiktok can be used as a positive thing and can be used as other learning media. In addition, there is a statement from a FB student: "For balqis Tiktok is used as a social media which can indeed generate learning, experience, interest in reading also for balqis itself".<sup>51</sup> MS: "I like reading on Tiktok, because there is a lot of knowledge and fun words"<sup>52</sup> WMA: "I love reading on Tiktok, especially about hadiths and sad words like that"<sup>53</sup> DEZ: "I like reading on Tiktok, especially when I don't have work anymore, so I don't get bored"<sup>54</sup>

### 3. Students Spend A Lot of Time Everyday on The Tiktok Application to Read

Based on researcher observations of how students use the Tiktok application every day for reading, we know that 4 out of 6 students spend their time reading on the Tiktok application each day. We also find that some students spend more time watching other videos on Tiktok than reading. Additionally, researchers found that the amount of time a student uses her Tiktok application can be increased by 4-5 hours per day. Students use her Tiktok not only as a means of entertainment and reading, but also as a tool to obtain information, and Tiktok is one of her fastest applications for information.

Based on the results of student interviews to see the use of the Tiktok application for daily reading of 6 students, there were four students who indeed spent a lot of time on Tiktok for reading and studying, and two students preferred watching entertainment videos rather than reading on the Tiktok application. Following are the answers of four students who spend their time reading on the Tiktok application, namely FB, MS, WMA and DEZ. In addition, there is a FB student statement: "I spend a lot of time on Tiktok, every time after school, before going to bed, when I wake up, and when I have free time I open Tiktok to read and read. check out more entertainment videos."<sup>55</sup> MS: "I don't count how long I read on TikTok miss, but often."<sup>56</sup> WMA : "When it comes to reading, every one of us reads it all, so as long as it's through FYP it's always read"<sup>57</sup> and DEZ: "I spend about 15 minutes on tiktok to read"<sup>58</sup>

# 4. Students consider the Tiktok application as a positive application if it is used properly, and students agree that the Tiktok application is used as a medium for students' reading interest.

To find out students' opinions about the Tiktok application is a positive application and to find out students' opinions if the Tiktok application is used as a reading medium, where students agree that the Tiktok application is a positive application if used correctly and 5 out of 6 students agree if Tiktok is used as a reading medium student.

Based on the results of the interviews, students consider that the Tiktok application is not all positive, there are also negative ones depending on how people use it, if he uses Tiktok for positive things, the homepage will always display positive things from the user's homepage. In addition, 5 out of 6 students use Tiktok as a medium for their interest in reading because they can read a lot of information, insights and insight on Tiktok according to FB, MS, WMA, DM and DEZ I agree that we can. You can also use your free time to read on tiktok. However, according to the AG, Tiktok cannot be used as a medium for engaging in reading. According to him, while using the TikTok application, he felt that it had nothing to do with his reading interests.

In addition, there is a statement from FB students: "Tiktok provides insight, experience because there are also many lessons such as Indonesian, English and even any formula is available on Tiktok, for Balqis students like Balqis who really need insight is also very helpful, so Balqis agrees that Tiktok is used as a reading medium."<sup>59</sup> MS: "Tiktok is suitable for use as a reading medium, because everyone there can share about learning."<sup>60</sup>

#### **B.** Discussion

Based on the research findings, the researchers found that the results of the research were based on the fact that the social media application, the tiktok application, is a medium that can increase their interest in reading. The social media application for the Tiktok application can make students addicted to

playing it so that they like to see information, learning, knowledge and insights contained in the Tiktok application. The tiktok social media application can also make them happy when they use the media to read. Especially when you're feeling tired, irritated or dizzy, play social media tiktoks and read motivational quotes or watch entertainment videos that you're going through, I feel like all those feelings are gone. Therefore, it can be said that the Tiktok application social media application is both a medium of interest in reading and entertainment for the students who use it.

Meanwhile, one student who was studied said that this application could not be used as a reading medium. Thus this research also proves that students can use the Tiktok application as their reading medium. The existence of this research also made researchers find out whether the tiktok application can make students interested in reading. And the existence of this research is also to make students know how influential the social media application tiktok they use is in their interest in reading. Therefore this research also makes them realize that they can spend a lot of time reading instead of watching unnecessary videos on Tiktok.

These results revealed that the Tiktok application's social media application had a positive relationship or impact on students' reading interests. Therefore, it is said that the Tiktok application's social media application can be of interest to reading students, even if there are few or no people using it in a classroom or school environment. The positive value of this study suggests that use of the social media application Tiktok is directly related to students' reading interest scores. The better a student's use of social media, the higher the student's reading interest score.

#### **CHAPTER V**

#### **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

#### A. Conclusion

Based on the research and observations of researchers regarding the use of social media Tiktok as a medium for students' interest in reading at SMPN 8 Langsa. Thus, it can be concluded that the tiktok application based on the proper use and method can be used as a fun, interactive, and creative reading tool. Various application features can provide convenience to students in accessing the reading environment and as a source of reference. Besides that, one of the social media that students use, namely Tiktok, provides many benefits for students, such as being used as an effective reading medium. Students who find it difficult to find information can easily find content creators in the TikTok application.

These results revealed that the Tiktok application's social media application had a positive relationship or impact on students' reading interests. That is why tiktok's social media application is said to influence students' interest in reading. This positive value indicates that the use of his Tiktok application, a social media application, is directly related to students' reading outcomes. The better you are at using social media, the more interest your students will have in reading.

#### **B.** Suggestion

Based on the conclusions above, the researcher provides the following suggestions:

- 1. For schools, it is expected to be able to improve facilities that support interest in reading so that students can achieve good learning outcomes and motivation
- 2. To students, students should continue to make Tiktok a means of reading and knowledge for users.
- 3. For other researchers, it is hoped that they can conduct research with a wider scope of knowledge.
