# THE EFFECTIVENESS OF USING PROBLEM BASED LEARNING (PBL) ON STUDENTS' SPEAKING PERFORMANCE OF SECOND GRADE STUDENTS AT SMA NEGERI 2 LANGSA.

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#### **ABSTRACT**

Studying speaking particularly foreign language is considered important in human life. Besides of acquiring native language, most people also study foreign languages. Even though English has been familiar for Indonesian students, but not every student can speak the language well. For example at SMA Negeri 2 Langsa. when the writer did a teaching training at the school, the writer observed the students' speaking ability. The writer found that there were some problems which are faced by the second grade students in English speaking class Based on the problem, the writer did a research to improve the students' speaking performance by using Problem Based Learning (PBL). The research belongs to experimental research which applied male class as experimental class and female class as the controlled class. The research was done by conducting pretest, treatment and posttest from 28<sup>th</sup> September until 09<sup>th</sup> October 2015. Based on the result of the research, the writer found that Problem Based Learning (PBL) can improve students' speaking performance at the second grade students of SMA Negeri 2 Langsa. The development can be seen from the speaking test result between experimental and controlled class. After conducting treatment, the students' speaking score at experimental class was 52,82 and the controlled class was 48,78. Based on the result of hypothesis testing, the researcher got that t  $_{observed} > t$  table <sub>based</sub> on the result of analysis, the writer got t <sub>observed</sub> is 3, 627 and t <sub>table</sub> is 2,825. It means that is 3,627 > 2,825. Therefore, Ha was accepted and Ho was rejected. Therefore, the Problem Based Learning (PBL) improve students' speaking performance at the second grade students of SMA Negeri 2 Langsa. According to the result of the research, the writer suggests the English teachers to apply Problem Based Learning (PBL) continuously. Therefore, the students can speak English creatively by sharing their problem directly.

Based on the problem, the writer did a research to improve the students' speaking performance by using Problem Based Learning (PBL).

The research belongs to experimental research. In this case, the writer applied two classes to conduct the research. The writer applied male class as experimental class, the class consist of 23 students. In the other words, the writer conducted female class as the controlled class that consists of 22 students. The research was done by conducting pretest, treatment and posttest from 28<sup>th</sup> September until 09<sup>th</sup> October 2015. In the first step, the writer conducted pre-test, the writer conducted speaking test for measure the students' speaking ability before conducting treatment. The writer applied pre-test for both experiment class and control class. Then, the writer conducted Problem Based Learning (PBL) for experimental class. Finally, the writer conducted post test, similar to pre-test the writer conducted post-test for experimental and control class. After conducting research, the writer analyzed the data statistically. The writer calculated the data to compare the students' speaking performance between experimental and control class.

Based on the result of the research, the writer found that Problem Based Learning (PBL) can improve students' speaking performance at the second grade students of SMA Negeri 2 Langsa. The development can be seen from the speaking test result between experimental and controlled class. After conducting treatment, the students' speaking score at experimental class was 52,82 and the controlled class was 48,78. Based on the result of hypothesis testing, the researcher got that t observed > t table based on the result of analysis, the writer got t observed is 3,627 and t table is 2,825. It means that is 3,627 > 2,825. Therefore, Ha was accepted and Ho was rejected. Therefore, the Problem Based Learning (PBL) improve students' speaking performance at the second grade students of SMA Negeri 2 Langsa.

According to the result of the research, the writer has suggestion for the reader. The writer suggests the English teachers to apply Problem Based Learning

Sometimes, the students rarely practice speaking because of the limited chance. The teacher only asks students to practice one of the conversations within the textbook. Consequently, some of students ignore to speak English and study it more.

Based on the fact above, it can be concluded that teaching speaking in this school need to be concerned. So, the writer tries to find out one of ways to solve the students' problems in studying speaking. The writer will apply Problem Based Learning method to stimulate the students to speak English. The Problem-Based Learning (PBL) method is both a teaching method and an approach to the curriculum. It consists of carefully designed problems that challenge students to use problem solving techniques, self-directed learning strategies, team participation skills, and disciplinary knowledge.<sup>1</sup>

Problem based learning is a method which is useful to help students' in learning speaking. Another large advantage of PBL is that it encourages students to gain a deeper sense of understanding. PBL also can increase students' motivation and make them interested to speak. By applying PBL, students have more chance to practice their speaking.

Based on the research which was done by Ridho, showed that "Problem Based Learning (PBL) bring some positive effects to the learning process of the
